Exploring Possibilities

- We explore areas of Health, Community, Home, Work, Skills, and Money
- Discovery process- A person may call in about one issue, then through exploration, we find out we can assist with something else
- During this process we find out what's important to them, help set goals and reach them!



Supporting Family & Youth

- Referral relevant articles and the Vault
- Explain benefit programs including how work affects benefits.
- Referrals to other agencies
- Offer follow up



Support for Professionals

- Act as a partner and offer support to the individual and those that support them
- Trouble shoot and help find solutions
- Referrals to other resources
- Staff can facilitate a conference call with individual and professional so that they can coordinate efforts






The Vault


