Functional Behavioral Assessment Checklist

"Functional behavioral assessment" or "FBA" means a process for gathering information to maximize the efficiency of behavioral supports.

- ✓ An FBA includes a description of problem behaviors AND
- ✓ The identification of:
 - o **Events** that predict the occurrence and nonoccurrence of the behavior,
 - o **Times** that predict the occurrence and nonoccurrence of the behavior,
 - and Situations that predict the occurrence and nonoccurrence of the behavior.
- ✓ An FBA also identifies:
 - The antecedents that maintain the behavior,
 - o The consequences that maintain the behavior,
 - o The reinforcers that maintain the behavior,
 - o Possible functions of the behavior, and
 - Possible positive alternative behaviors.
- ✓ An FBA includes a *variety* of data collection methods and sources that facilitate the development of:
 - o **hypotheses** regarding behavioral patterns, and
 - o **summary statements** regarding behavioral patterns.

"Functional behavioral assessment" or "FBA" means a process for gathering information to maximize the efficiency of behavioral supports. An FBA includes a description of problem behaviors and the identification of events, times, and situations that predict the occurrence and nonoccurrence of the behavior. An FBA also identifies the antecedents, consequences, and reinforcers that maintain the behavior, the possible functions of the behavior, and possible positive alternative behaviors. An FBA includes a variety of data collection methods and sources that facilitate the development of hypotheses and summary statements regarding behavioral patterns.
